



School Closure Outbreak Scenarios

When a positive case is identified in a district facility local public health, community medical advisors, and district administration will collaborate to determine the district response.

Possible scenarios that could result in school closure	During the investigation	After the investigation
1 confirmed case (staff, student or visitor) in school	Close the classroom and transition to remote learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classroom remains closed for 14 days ● Close contacts of the positive case quarantine for 14 days
2 or more cases linked together in school, in the same classroom	Close the classroom and transition to remote learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classroom remains closed for 14 days ● Close contacts of positive cases quarantine for 14 days
2 or more cases linked together in school, but in different classrooms	Close the school building and transition to remote learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classrooms of each case remain closed for 14 days ● Close contacts of positive cases quarantine for 14 days ● Other staff and students quarantine based on where the exposure took place (e.g. locker room, cafeteria) ● The school building reopens after the investigation is complete
2 or more cases where a link cannot be determined	Close the school building and transition to remote learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The entire school remains closed for a total of 14 days
